# Become a River Giver

West Cumbria rivers trust strives to restore and enhance the value of rivers, lakes, estuaries and surrounding countryside throughout West Cumbria for the benefit of people and wildlife. Our work covers a large area of Cumbria; from the river annas in bootle to the river Wampool just north of silloth. much of our work involves working with our sponsors, funders and partners to achieve the following aims:

Restore the biodiversity and function of the rivers and lakes in our care

Reduce pollution inputs to watercourses from catchment land

Monitor key flora and fauna populations and make use of existing data and evidence to inform targeting of restoration actions

Educate and engage local communities

to achieve our aims we work at a full catchment scale and with a wide range of partners, using the best available data to prioritise work that will make a real difference. these include river restoration projects, natural flood risk management, habitat improvement projects, electrofishing surveys and walkover surveys, tree planting, stopping the spread of invasive species, fencing projects to keep stock out of rivers and fish easement projects. We are also supporting critically endangered species including the freshwater mussel (*margaritifera margaritifera*) in the river ehen and river lrt, as well as running education sessions and community events. please see our website for more information on all of our projects.

We also have lots of new and exciting projects in the pipeline as well as events and volunteer opportunities so keep an eye on our website, social media pages and newsletter for more information and updates.
